

The **Private Career Training Institutions Agency (PCTIA)** ensures consumer protection for students through the registration and accreditation of private career training institutions. PCTIA was established via legislation as a not-for-profit regulatory and consumer protection agency in 2004, and became a crown agency in 2009. Unique in Canada and North America, the Agency was created as a self-regulating body operating under a cost-recovery model governed by a Board of Directors made up of industry elected representatives and government appointed public interest members. PCTIA requires basic education standards as set out by the Agency for all of its approximately 400 registered institutions and also offers a voluntary accreditation process to registered institutions.
