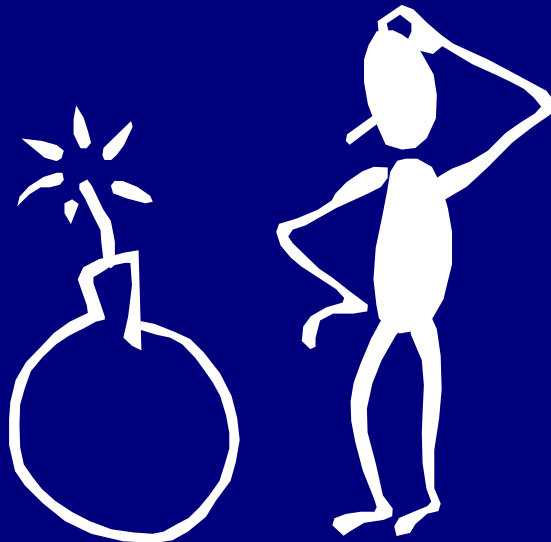

  - Personalize to the user

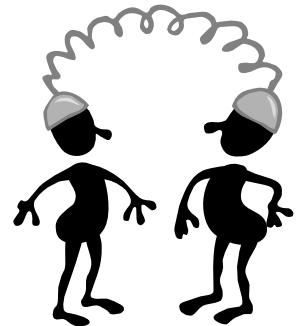
# Accessibility

- ☐ Easy search access

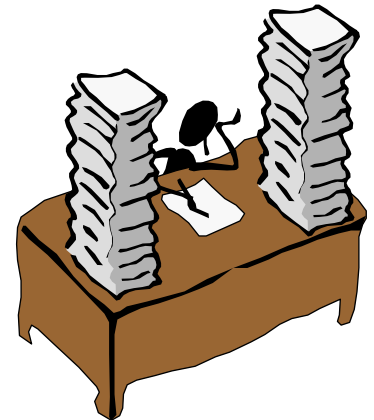

# Physical Space

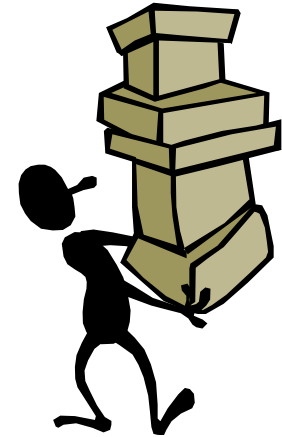
- No need for big filing cabinets

  - Don't have to leave desk to access it



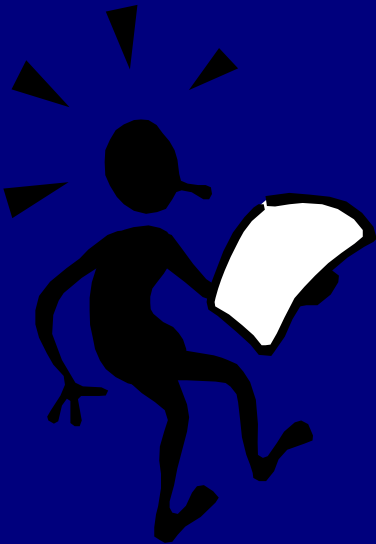


# Reduced Costs

  - Maximize staff potential – improved morale

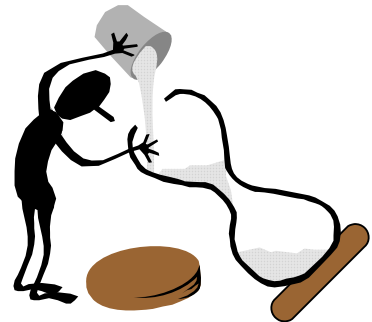


# Lessons Learned

**“We’ve got amazing staff and we need to keep them happy! The freedom from the photocopier and filing system is significant: has allowed them to work on other projects.”**

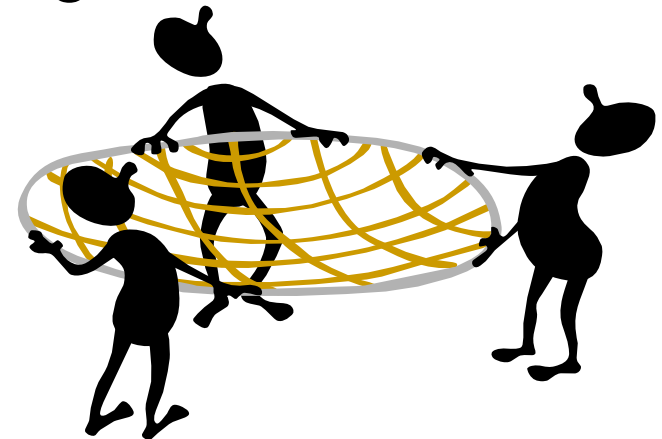

  - FOIPOP requests require paper copies of student records

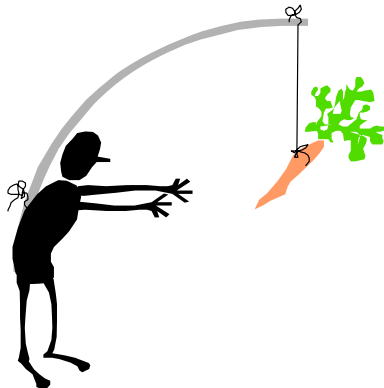
# Communication and Training
